Through the years, the program has expanded to include topics in recent advances in ORL research.

As founder of this International Academic Conference in Otolaryngology, it gives me great pleasure to see its continued growth in attendance and importance. There is a lot more that we can do. In March 2018, we shall all gather in Manila, Philippines. I am sure we will all have a wonderful time - exchanging ideas among colleagues, meeting old friends and making new ones, and discovering the beauty of our host country.
